



Sayre Street Races Rules & Regulations

DRIVERS:

Registration for Drivers & Tech Inspection will be at the Driver's Parking Lot from 4:00 pm to 7:30 pm. Registration is \$30 day of race. \$20 in Advance.

Drivers Meeting is at 6:30 pm at the Registration Trailer. Racing will begin at 7:00 pm. Open Racing will be from 7:00 pm to Midnight. This is true Grudge Match - you pick your race. Jr. Dragsters will run at 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Please encourage our youth racers! This is our next generation of racers!

At 9:00 pm the Cash Shoot Outs will begin. You MUST buy in at the Registration Table before 8:00 pm so you can be bracketed prior to start of the Shoot Out to cut down on lag time. No monies refunded in event of withdrawal from Shoot Out. **Grudge races will still take place during the shoot out to keep the action going!** Drivers line up in the right hand staging lane directly *in front of or behind* the person they are racing, not side by side. This ensures racing continues non-stop and without interruptions. This also keeps left lane clear for pit crew golf carts and staff to use in emergencies.

PIT CREWS:

Each Driver will receive a Driver's Wristband and two Pit Crew Bands. **All individuals in Pit Crew must be the age of 14 or over to be in the staging lanes and cul-de-sac.** Additional Pit Crew Wrist bands are available for \$20 each for those 14 years and up. NO CHILDREN UNDER IN THE CUL-DE-SAC. All people purchasing Pit Crew Wrist Bands must sign liability waivers.

Family and children who are not *directly helping* with the car are not allowed in the Cul-De-Sac and staging lanes. They will need to view the races from the spectator sections. NO BEER OR ALCOHOL ALLOWED IN THE STAGING LANES OR CULDESAC.

Requirements to Race

- ◆ Current Tag & Insurance required. Must have proof of Insurance. Driver must be listed on Insurance Policy.
- ◆ Working Seatbelt.
- ◆ Helmet required.
- ◆ No Major Leaks & ***NO Mud or Dirt on Undercarriage.***
- ◆ All Lug Nuts must be in place.
- ◆ Working Headlights and Taillights.
- ◆ No dry rot or belts showing on tires.
- ◆ Drivers must wear fire jacket or long sleeve cotton or denim shirts.
- ◆ No shorts allowed. Must wear long pants, FRC or denim/cotton.
- ◆ No open toed shoes.
- ◆ No passengers allowed while you are racing without prior approval, safety gear, and required releases.
- ◆ ***NO DRUGS OR DRINKING. 100% No Tolerance. If a driver is suspected of being under the influence you will be ejected from the races. No alcohol allowed in staging lanes or cul-de-sac, be it pit crew or others with pit passes.***
- ◆ No fighting or horseplay allowed on the line. Anyone found to be aggressive or rowdy on the line will be ejected.
- ◆ No Convertibles without Roll Cage.

All Driver's & Pit Crews must wear their wrist band and present it to personnel when entering or leaving the race areas.

All Street Racers vehicles will have a number chalked on the car. If you have been teched you will have your number. Cars who have not been teched and numbered will not be allowed to race.

This is a family fun event, and we have taken every step we can to make it a safe one as well! This is grudge racing! It is not worth risking your life! If you feel yourself losing control, get out of it. Do not keep it hammered and risk hurting yourself, your competitor, or the fans.
